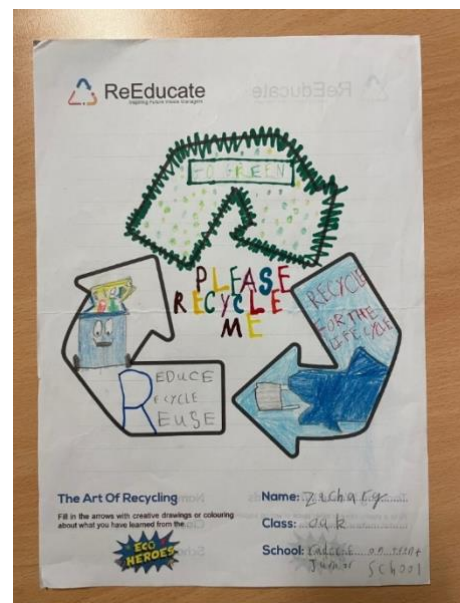


linked up with two of their Community Business Partners to organise a school visit local to one of their sites to deliver our EcoHeroes ReEducate sessions.

What did Go Green do?

ReEducate

Go Green reached out to Radcliffe on Trent Junior School, and their Eco Leader, Gail Radcliffe. Working closely with Gail, we planned to visit the school to deliver our Eco Heroes programme to Year 4 students, who were learning about plastic pollution. Due to the close link within the waste industry we adapted our programme slightly to ensure it had a heavier focus on plastics than our standard version, and arranged a date to visit the school that was during this time.



On 21st September, Go Green's Sustainability Manager and Social Engagement Coordinator headed to Radcliffe on Trent Junior School and delivered the EcoHeroes programme, alongside Gail, to around 90 students over a course of three sessions.

During the sessions, the students learnt about waste, what happens to their waste, what landfill is and the effects of landfill on the environment. The programme also included the 3 R's (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle), and how to make better choices to protect the planet. At the end of the day, the students were left with an activity to complete after the day.

GreenEthos

On 2nd November, our Social Engagement Coordinator (Alex) went back to Radcliffe on Trent Junior School to carry out a litter pick in collaboration with the school and Farrans. Accompanied by ten students from the school's eco community, Alex led a litter pick which ventured firstly around the school grounds, and circulated around the local village, along the main high street.
