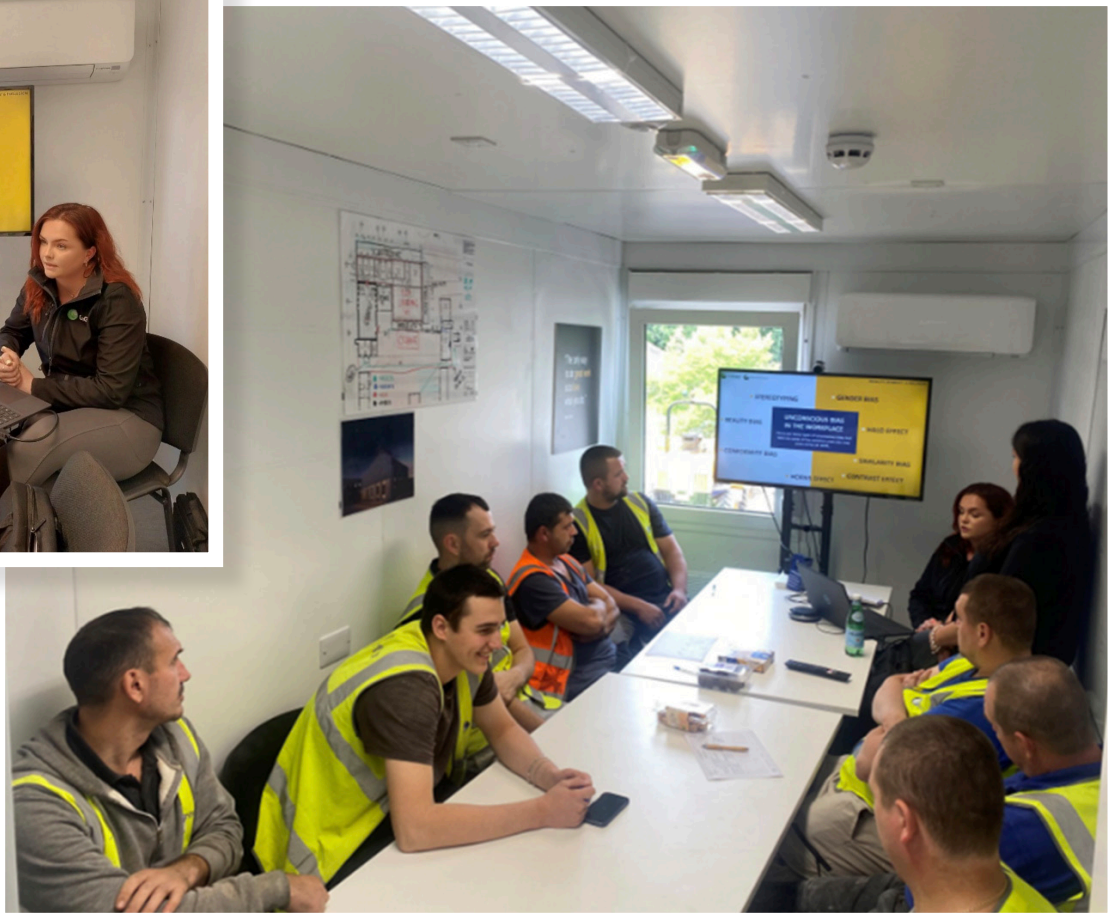
- The Equality Act 2010 and the protected characteristics.
